We are pleased to announce that we have opened additional five master's courses and five doctoral courses for the 2024 KOICA Scholarship Program. Program Information (PI) for each course are available on the KOICA CIAT website https://www.koica.go.kr/sites/ciat/index.do Each applicant can only apply for one course. We highly recommend applicants to read the application guideline (attached herewith) and PI thoroughly to know an overview of the requirements for KOICA and the universities. The applicants must submit all required application documents by email to KOICA Viet Nam Office at koicavn.ciat@gmail.com by 11:00 P.M., 22 March 2024 for KOICA round.

Eligible applicants must hold citizenship of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam and be government employees. In addition, all applicants must submit an official nomination letter from

the applicant's affiliated organization to KOICA Viet Nam Office to bear all responsibilities related to absconding and absence without leave issues. If the applicant's affiliated organization is not a government body of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam, the applicant has to provide additional documents proving that the organization has the authority granted from the government body to nominate their employees for the scholarship. Especially, if applicants submit false documents, the organization where they belong to will be restricted from recommending new applicants for the next three years. KOICA highly recommends that Scholarship Program participants make professional contributions to their organization at least one year after finishing the course.

At the KOICA round, KOICA Viet Nam Office will contact shortlisted applicants for a screening interview. Then we will nominate the most qualified candidates from the country to move on to the next stage for a competition with nominees from other participating countries for the 2024 KOICA Scholarship Program. Selected applicants will be required to submit necessary documents for admission to universities in the ways that universities will provide individual guidance to respective applicants and by the timeline which may vary for each university.

Regarding this, it would be highly appreciated if you could make the 2nd announcement for the 2024 KOICA Scholarship Program widely accessible to government employees and recommend eligible applicants.
